Dear Mr. Crisp:

Based upon your certification for the transmission electron microscopic determination of asbestos by the National Institute of Standards and Technology through its National Voluntary Laboratory Accreditation Program, your agreement to use approved U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) methodology, and your demonstrated ability to analyze correctly performance evaluation samples, you are granted certification for analyzing asbestos in drinking water under the Safe Drinking Water Act.

In order to maintain your certification status, the following requirements as outlined in the *Manual for the Certification of Laboratories Analyzing Drinking Water* (EPA 570/9-90/008 as changed) must be met: 1) satisfactorily analyzing periodic performance evaluation samples; 2) using methodologies sanctioned by the drinking water regulations or otherwise approved by the U.S. EPA; 3) notifying the certifying authority within 30 days of major changes in personnel, equipment or location; and 4) undergoing a satisfactory on-site evaluation.

Any State in which you do business is free to accept or not accept this certification - you are advised to check with that State's certifying authority. This certification is valid for a period of three years from the date of this letter unless sooner withdrawn or changed.
